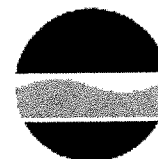

Permit Renewal Information Required

Dear Applicant Agent :

The Department received your application to renew the referenced Solid Waste Management permit on 04/01/2022. The review of your application is undertaken pursuant to the provisions of the Department's Uniform Procedures regulation, 6 NYCRR Part 621. Additionally, the status of your current permit is governed by the State Administrative Procedures Act (SAPA).

Specifically, the SAPA allows your current permit to continue in effect beyond its expiration date of 09/30/2022 if the Department is unable to make a final decision on the permit renewal application prior to permit expiration, but only if the renewal application submission is both timely and sufficient. Operations under a continued permit are limited to only those activities expressly authorized by the current permit. Renewal application submissions that are not both timely and sufficient are not afforded permit continuance past the permit's expiration date. Accordingly, staff has reviewed your renewal application and has made the following determinations:

The application for permit renewal is timely and sufficient and, therefore, the existing permit will remain in effect past its expiration date, under the State Administrative Procedures Act, until the Department's decision on permit renewal. However, the Department requires additional information to complete its review and make a decision on renewing the permit. The information is requested in accordance with provisions of the Uniform Procedures regulation per 6 NYCRR 621.14(b). This gives the Department the authority to request, in writing, any information which is reasonably necessary to make any findings or determinations required by law at any time during the review of an application for permit. The additional information required is identified below and must be provided to the Department no later than **08/26/2022**. Failing to timely respond may be grounds for permit denial.

The following information is required based upon the review of the Clean Water of New York submission dated March 2022:
